

Educational Improvement Tax Credit Program (EITC)

Known for its academic reputation, Devon Prep encourages all qualified students, regardless of race, religion or economic means to apply for admission. In that light the school offers generous scholarship and financial aid packages totaling nearly 20% of its annual budget.

Devon Prep is an approved scholarship organization for the Pennsylvania Educational Improvement Tax Credit Program (EITC).

The Department of Community & Economic Development created this program to give businesses an incentive to support schools like Devon Prep instead of paying taxes to Harrisburg. Companies can contribute to an approved organization like Devon Prep, and receive up to a 90% state tax credit to offset the contribution.



The program provides more than \$40 million in state tax credits. You can turn your tax dollars into donations. Instead of sending tax dollars to Harrisburg, your company can reallocate them to support Devon Prep's financial aid program, to directly help a student benefit from a Devon Prep education.

The following businesses paying taxes in Pennsylvania can receive up to \$300,000 in tax credits annually through the EITC program: C-Corporations (taxed at the corporate level), S-Corporations, Partnerships, Sole Proprietors, Limited Liability Companies (LLC's). Last year, the program was expanded to include subchapter S corporations and other business entities that pay their State business taxes under the personal income tax on PA business income can now fully participate.

To participate in this exciting program companies need to apply to the State Department of Community and Economic Development. Once the state approves the request a donation can be made directly to Devon Preparatory School.
