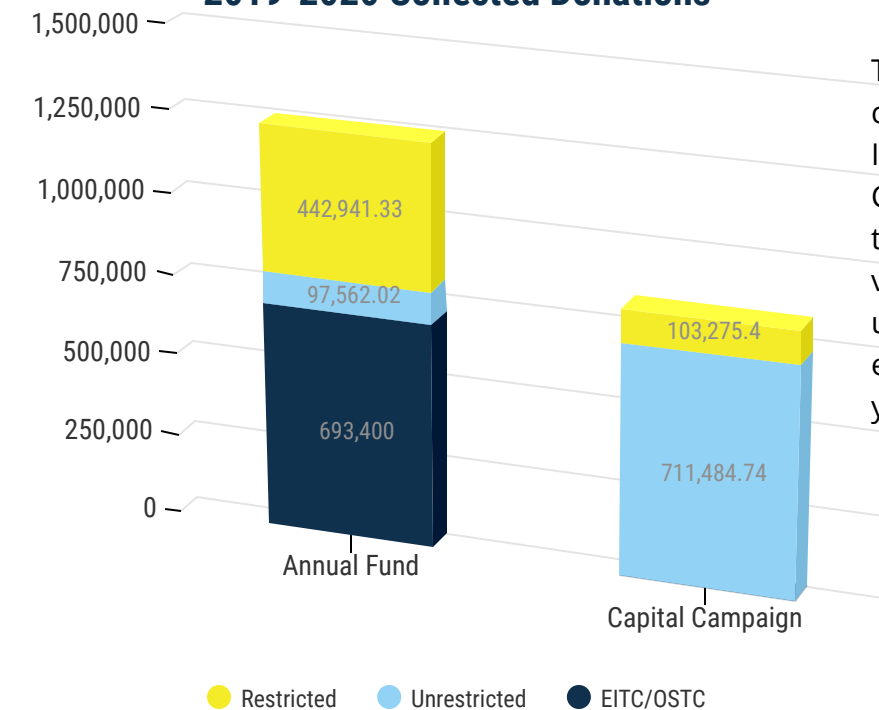
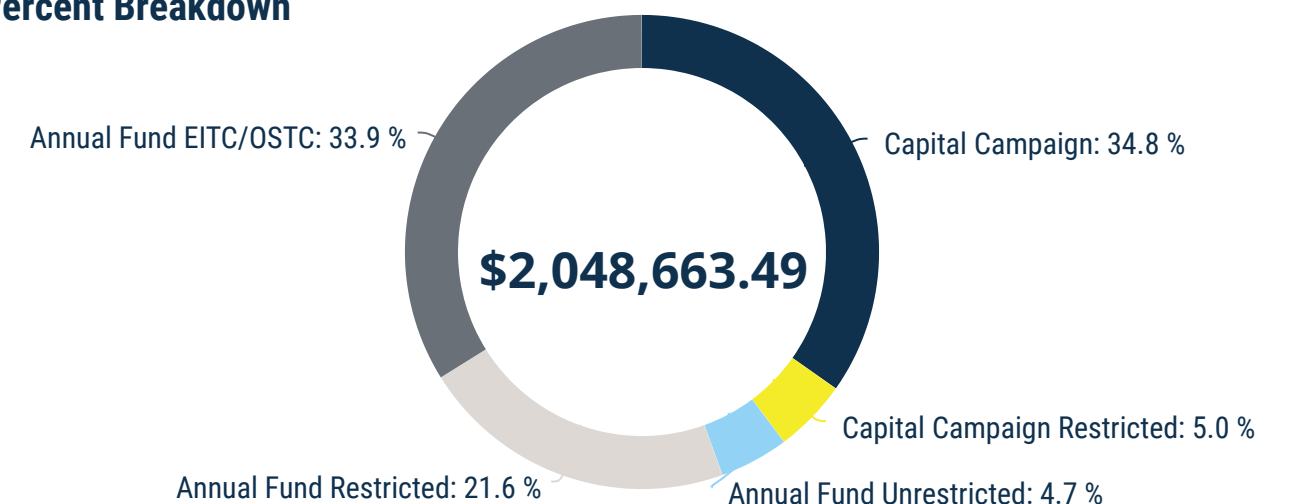


Chart Description

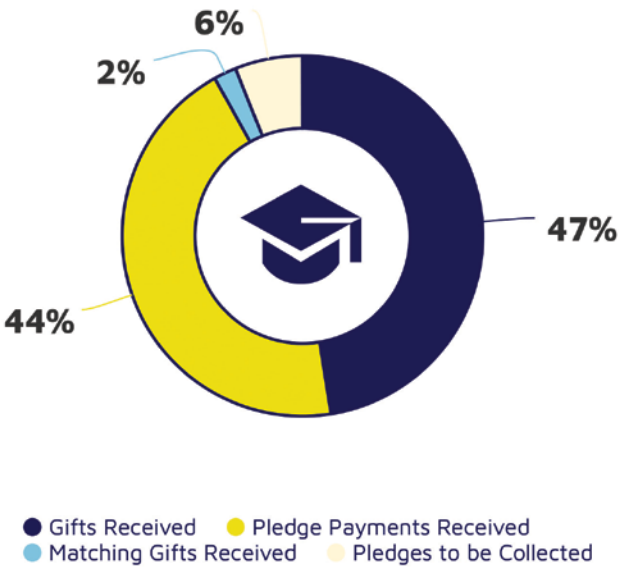

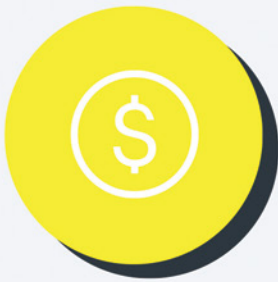
