

Devon Prep's Fundraising Review & Performance




Chart Description



There is a simple PLEDGE that we ask our boys to follow daily.

- 1. Act and speak with kindness, tolerance, and respect toward everyone.
- 2. Perform my responsibilities with honesty and integrity.
- 3. Follow these principles in school and out.
- 4. Expect my classmates to do the same.

The four sentences above seem simple enough. In society today, expecting others to live by the same pledge isn't so simple. The impact of the media, and of social media, on the world and on our student body is undeniable, so we focus our efforts on maintaining an environment where our boys can learn, feel safe, and be happy. And we are lucky here at Devon Prep. We are blessed with great families, great students, and great faculty and staff - all of whom respect each other's differences and look out for the common good of one another.

Devon Prep is a place where our boys are given the space to showcase their strengths, grow through their failures, and BE THEMSELVES. We are achieving community diversity in many different ways at Devon, preparing our boys - and quite frankly ourselves - for a better future. The support we've received from our families and Alumni has helped lead the charge forward.

Over the past two years - through some of the toughest times many of us have ever had - we have seen our community grow STRONGER. We opened the 2021-2022 school year with the highest enrollment in school history. At 309 boys Devon Prep is thriving! Take a closer look inside that number and you'll find 53 students (17%) have a diverse ethnic background - more than a 51% growth since 2016. Additionally, we have 67 faculty and staff members, 21% of which come from diverse ethnic backgrounds. Just over half the faculty and staff members are female, and 70% of the faculty and staff members hold advanced degrees. Quite a drastic change from when I started a decade ago, and while the work is never done, we're happy to show how far Devon Prep has come.

While test scores don't always tell the whole story, you should know what our students are capable of. Even through a pandemic we saw our average SAT score improve by 70 points and the school average overall SAT score now sits at a robust 1270 - 188 points higher than the State average. Equally impressive are the scores related to AP testing. 26 AP classes were offered last year, and 377 tests were taken overall. Our boys scored an average of 3 or better in 19 of the 26 AP tests, and a 4 or better in 6 of them. In 4 AP courses all our boys scored a 3 or better. Our boys also outperformed scoring on a State (17 of 26) and National (16 of 26) level. What's even more astounding is that every single student taking an AP Class MUST take the AP test - this is optional at all other schools.

Just as the pandemic couldn't stop our students inside the classroom, it couldn't stop us from revamping those classrooms and adding to the campus! In March we completed a major renovation of "The Cottage", turning it into the Devon Creative Suite. This allowed us to bolster our Tech Arts curriculum, as we now offer courses in Robotics, MakerSpace and 3D Design on Macs. Additionally, this new home allowed us to convert two existing classrooms into custom rooms for Studio Art and Music. Alongside these physical upgrades, we also offer - for the first time ever - four new AP courses in 2-D Art and Design and Music. This commitment to Tech and Fine Arts is helping reshape how Devon is viewed by the broader community, and advances our mission to provide a holistic education.

And there is more to come! During the 2020-2021 school year over 86% of our student body participated in at least one sport - a staggering statistic. Many of our seniors chose their college destination based on the opportunity to play their sport at the next level, and we celebrate their successes. We have been working with our neighbors and Tredyffrin Township over the past two years to gain approval and get started on a much-needed renovation of our existing sports field. We anticipate breaking ground this school year, and will construct a state-of-the-art artificial playing field as well as a 10,000-square-foot indoor training facility that will give us flexibility in operations budget, better balance to our boys schedules, and a first-class playing experience for all our teams.

Community. We are building one here through everyone's differences, and that's ok. We make decisions - and we know sometimes not everyone agrees - but they are done with the intention of the greater good and the longevity of our great school. As much as we love to celebrate our individual students' accomplishments, each is just a part in the story we will write over time.

Yes, we are proud of all we are achieving but know there is always more work to be done. I hope you've enjoyed hearing about where Devon stands today and where we are going and hope that you continue to keep us in mind and support our students, and great school.
